

SCIAF Achievements

With many parts (you) working together, SCIAF (part of the Catholic Church in Scotland) have done amazing things. Here's a just a few!

- +SCIAF was established in 1965 by Head Teacher John McKee
- +The first annual appeal in 1965 raised over £4000 (a lot of money back then)
- +By 1968 total diocesan donations was £39,400
- +In 1984-85 we saw a period of extreme famine in Ethiopia. The Catholic Church in Scotland with SCIAF raised a huge £575,000 to help with emergency aid.
- +In the first 30 years of SCIAF's existence, £22 million was donated to help people in emergencies and to help them for the long-term.
- +In 2005 SCIAF join with others in one of the biggest campaigns in the UK to 'Make poverty History'
- +In 2007 SCIAF sent over £5.4 million to projects in Africa, Asia and Latin America.
- +When disasters hit Haiti, Ethiopia and Pakistan in 2010, SCIAF helped well over 100,000 people to receive emergency food, shelter, hygiene kits and clean water.
- +Figures in 2018 tell us that in this year alone we helped over 2 million 752 thousand people overcome challenges such as hunger, war, natural disasters and injustice raising over £8 million!
