Christina lives with her mum and two nephews - Jude and Daniel. Jude is 4 years old and Daniel is 18 months old.

Her nephews are the sons of her older sister, Charlene.



Christina wakes up at 6am. She goes to collect water for the family.



Christina also helps her mum in the morning by sweeping up the house.



Then she washes the dishes.



Christina then takes a shower and gets dressed for school.



Christina walks for one hour to get to school.



She studies French, mathematics, grammar, music, handwriting and sciences. But her favourites subjects to study are geography and history.



After she returns from school, Christina helps her mum by bringing manure to the field and picking vegetables.



Her mum cooks dinner for the family.



Christina helps to prepare dinner. The family eat different vegetables like amaranth, cabbage, aubergine and cassava, plus bread.



Christina's friends live close by and they play a game called Kange. She goes to bed at 8pm



When she grows up, Christina wants to be a doctor so she can cure peoples illness.
