# A VITAL VEGGIE GARDEN





#### **REAL GIFTS ACTIVITY SHEET**

Your gift of a vegetable garden helps families to grow fresh and healthy vegetables, and herbs on their own small plot of land. This not only provides people with healthy food options but also allows them to sell their produce in local markets for additional income, promoting self-sustainability. Watch life grow!

Our partners train families in Agro-ecology to help them set up and maintain their vegetable gardens. This means:

#### Choosing the best location

(ideally near the house and close to a water source)

 Preparing the soil (creating raised beds and using homemade

fertiliser)

• Planting their seeds

(spacing them out and placing into the soil instead of scattering)

- Watering (knowing when and how much to water)
- Managing the garden (getting rid of fungus or insects in a natural chemical-free way)

#### FACTS

- Globally 811 million people are facing hunger in the world
- 60% of those suffering from chronic hunger are women and girls
- Vegetables like sweet potato, carrot, onion, cabbage and varieties of cucumbers and spinach are common in vegetable gardens in Africa and Asia.

#### REFLECTION

Use this time to praise the Lord, 'praise Him from the heavens, praise Him all his angels' (Psalms 148:1-2) and thank Him for everything he has created. Every person, unique and in his image. Every grain of soil, every drop of water, every creature on the ground and in the sky. Creation sings of God's qualities and magnitudes.

- Chickens can lay 4-7 eggs per week
- Each egg contains over 70 calories and provides essential calories and nutrition for families who eat one meal a day
- Keeping chickens uses less water and land than other animals, which is better for the environment.
