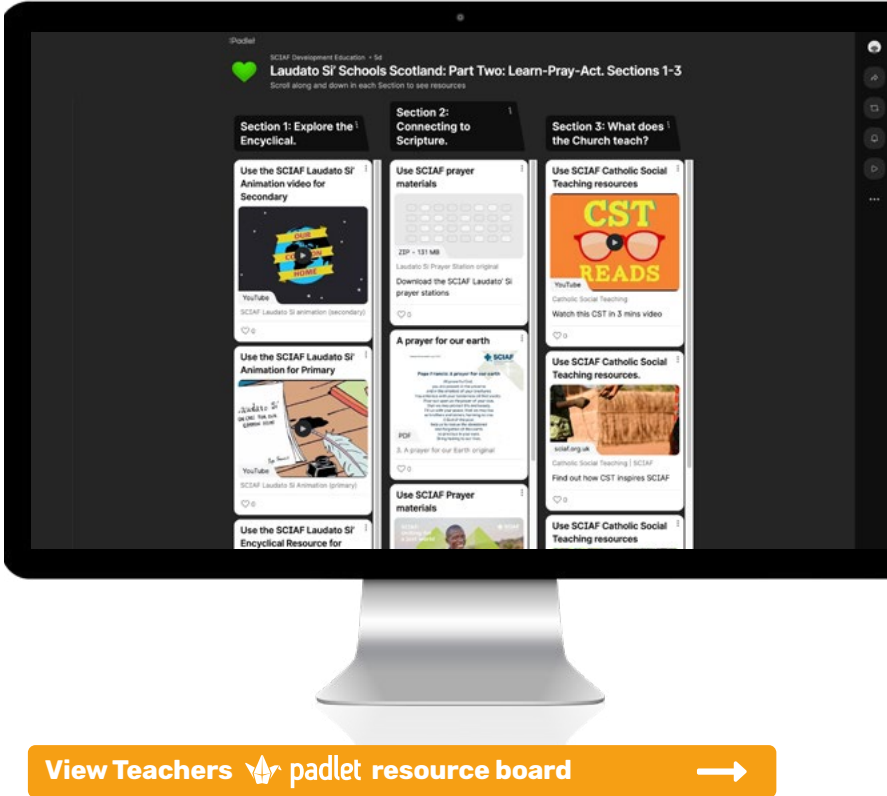
Section 1

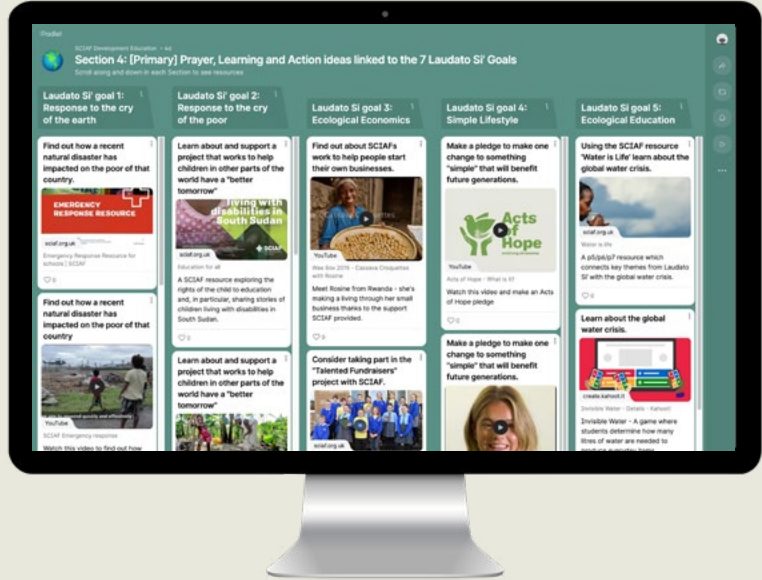

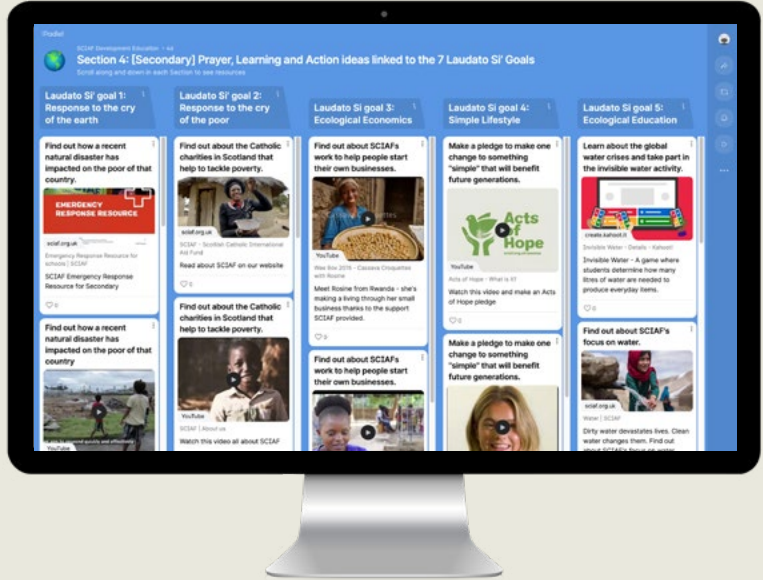

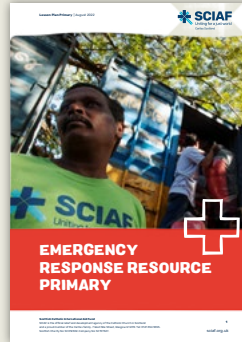
